Important Reminders:

Teacher Shortage

Important Reminders:

Late Arrival

Some students are making a habit of arriving late to school. The names are recorded and soon letters will be issued for parents to have a discussion with the head of school. This is not to condemn anyone but to find the root of the problem and find out solutions as to how this can be improved. If students continuously miss first period, then they may not meet the criteria of completing the current years required classes.

Meals

Ensure that children always bring healthy meals and snacks to school. No fizzy drinks are allowed. A humble request to all parent/guardians to send lunch with their child in the morning to avoid disturbances during lesson times.

Graffiti and Vandalism

Some students are deliberately carrying ink pens, colored markers and are writing on walls especially inside the toilets and are also evidences of damaging of school properties. This must stop. Please do advise your children. If they are caught then they will have to bear the burden of the cost of repairing, repainting and maintenance.

Phone Contacts

I am requesting all parents and guardians to ensure they are in the form **VIBER PLATFORM** so that they are updated with current information. The teachers and I would like to be in touch with you all the time. Do notify the form teachers if the numbers are changed.

Phones

Students are not allowed to bring phones to school. If phones are lost, school will not be responsible and will not be carrying out investigation works in this regard.

Romantic Relationship

School will no longer condone such behaviors. Many photos and videos of students in uniforms have gone viral. Now that reminders are given, any student who are found in these cases in or out of the school will be severely dealt with, which may result in re location of school.

School Dispersal Time

The school finishes by 3.30pm from Monday – Thursday and 3.00pm on Friday. Parents are requested to pick their children at earliest possible time. And by 3.50pm no students should be loitering in the premises.

Vehicles to school
