## **TERM I NEWS LETTER 2 – 2024**

**Dear Parents/ Guardians** 

Greetings from Nadi Muslim College

Asalaamu Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahi Wa Barkaatahu.

This is week 11 of term 1. Thank you to all of you for the hard work and perseverance in sending your children/ward to school. Some important reminders and information that I would like to bring to your attention are as follows:

- 1. <u>Staffing</u>: We are pleased to announce we have received all academic teachers. We would like to thank Ministry of Education in facilitating our request.
- 2. <u>Eid-ul -Fitr</u>: The day of celebration will be determined upon the sighting of the moon. If the new moon is sighted on Wednesday 10th Eid-ul-Fitr will be celebrated on Thursday 11th April, 2024, otherwise on Friday 12th April, 2024. Approval has been given by Ministry of Education for the closure of school to observe Eid-Ul-Fitr. We will update all parents through the class Viber group.

- 3. <u>Parent-Teacher Discussion Forum:</u> The Parent-Teacher discussion will be held in week 12 from 15/04/24 to 19/04/24 from 3. 20p.m to 4. 00p.m for all levels and will be addressed by the Head of School. The purpose of this Parent-Teacher is to discuss the concerns arising and how the Form Teachers may assist both the parents and the child to find solutions.
- 4. Attendance and Punctuality: All parents are encouraged to ensure that their children are in school every day. All students are to be in school by 7.45 am for the DEAR programme. - 6. <u>Parent Teacher Interview</u>: The students have completed two shorts test in week 12. The comparative analysis of the two short tests will be discussed in the PTI meeting. The PTI will be held in Week 14, Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2024.
- 7. Sporting Activities: There are a lot of sporting activities during Terms 1 and 2. As informed earlier, participating will be given consent letters from the school. Sporting activities are part of holistic development and is a medium to improve discipline. This should not be used as an excuse for poor academic performance. All sporting activities will cease by the end of term 2.
- 8. Arrival and Departure Time of Students: The first period begins at 8.10 a.m. Please note prior plannings are required. There was a lot of students coming late to school. Students staying close to school should be in school by 7.50am.

- 10. Henna Application: Henna is NOT allowed in school.
- 11. Restricted and Prohibited items: Mobile phones, Smart Watch, make up items, perfumes, radios, CDs, Ear Piece, flash drive, cameras, prohibited magazines, all games (computer, cards, board games, etc) razor blades, cutting knives and other electronic gadgets are NOT at all times. Teachers with Prefects may carry out spot check at any time and all items confiscated will be returned to parents at the end of the year. Items classified as dirty and dangerous will be incinerated and necessary disciplinary action will be taken.
- 12. <u>Discipline, Uniform, Shoes, Hair style:</u> All parents and guardian are requested to help the College by monitoring every morning the appearance of their children so that their uniform, shoes, hairstyle, shaving for boys and general appearance befits that of school students.
