Greetings from Nadi Muslim College to the parents/guardians. We thank you for your continued support and co-operation throughout this term.

1. Mid-Year Examination

All parents/guardians are acknowledged for their effort in sending their child/ward for this important exam for this term. The attendance was almost 90%. The exam commenced on Friday 21st June, 2024 and ended on Friday 28th June, 2024 with all students from Years 9 – 13 sitting for this exam. It is a reminder for parents/guardians that all exams are mandatory. Parents/Guardians are to see the Principal regarding any grievances they their have about child/ward's attendance.

2. After Mid-Year Examination

Normal teaching and learning will continue in the days after the examination. All students are required to attend school. It has been brought to our attention that some students continue to be absent after exams and I am afraid if the trend continues your child might <u>Not be able to appear for</u> <u>exams as per section 6.2.1.1 and 6.2.1.2</u> <u>of the examination policy.</u>

3. Parent-Teacher Interview (PTI)

The Mid-Year Examination PTI will be conducted in **Week 8 on Friday 12/07/2024).** It is mandatory for all parents/guardians to get feedback for their child/ward's strengths and weaknesses so that teachers and parents/guardians can collaborate for learning in Term 2 and 3 and for the upcoming examinations.

4. Programme for Week 7 to week 14

1st – 2nd July – IDADAIT Week. All students will be addressed and the above issues. Classes will be normal up to week 14. There will be interform sports. Student Council Sports Day competition on Friday and Saturday (09/08/2024) (10/08/2024). Students will take part through entries in various sports. The funds collected by the student's council will be used for student council project and that is School Signage work. Test Week – Week 9 (15th July – 19th July, 2024) – Enterprising Activities.

5. Sports Report

The school has been taking part in all sports. This includes soccer, rugby, netball and cricket. The school u17 team is out on contention for finals but u15 and 19 soccer teams ate in contention. Rugby Under 17 has qualified for Zonal quarters and students are also taking part in netball.

6. <u>School Fundraising:</u> We are awaiting the approval from Madam PS on the school fundraising for the school Hall. The dates for the fundraising are 9th to 10th of August 2024 at the school grounds. We are requesting all the school stakeholders to come in numbers and support your school for this worthy course. There will be a lot of fun activities for the whole community, food will be on sale as well.

- Absenteeism: It has ben brought to our attention that students are absent a lot. Requesting all students to come to school every day and be mindful of Ministry of Education Examination and Assessment Policy and Eligibility to appear for examination.
- 8. Late Arrivals: Some students are deliberately coming late to school. We are requesting all students to be early to school. Reporting time is 7.45 am. Late students will be given letters and warned.
- 9. **Prohibited Items:** Make up items, perfumes, radios, CDs, I pods, flash drive, cameras, prohibited magazines, (computer, cards, board all games games, etc) razor blades. cuttina knives and other electronic gadgets are not to be brought to the College. Mobile phone and smart watches are strictly not allowed. Teachers may carry out spot check at any time and all items confiscated will be returned to parents the end of the year. at Items and dangerous will classified as dirty be incinerated and necessary disciplinary action will be taken as deemed necessary
- 10. Uniform: All parents and guardian are requested to help the College by monitoring every morning the appearance of their children so that their uniform, shoes, hairstyle, shaving for boys and general appearance befits that of school students. Unwarranted fancy haircut/styles will not be tolerated. Also, please regularly talk to your children, as they may have many issues that they may need to talk about or need your assistance with. Nadi Muslim College prides itself in the discipline of our students and we request co-operation your in maintaining it.

- 11. <u>Bringing Private Vehicles to School</u>: School <u>Does not</u> allow any student bringing private vehicles to school. Requesting parents to be informed that school DOES NOT ALLOW students to bring cars or vehicles to school. That a standing rule. The school will not enter in any agreement regarding these issues.
- 12. Saturday and Afternoon Classes: The school will conduct afternoon and Saturday Classes soon. Parents will be given consent forms per Saturday classes so that you are aware of the dates and the time of these classes.
- 13. Quran Reading Classes:

The school maktab classes are conducted every morning and afternoon. Requesting parents to drop the students early so that we can continue to work this activity. Morning class starts at 7,30am and afternoon classes starts at 2.15 pm.

14. <u>School Clearnce</u>: All students will be cleared from school at the end of academic year 2024 and all students have to re-enroll with current and valid documents. After re enrollment students will be given an acceptance letter ensuring students are meeting the minimum standards while coming back for new academic year. Which means all students need to adhere to enrollment rules.
