Dear Parents/Guardians,

Assalamu Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahi Wa Barkaatuhu and Warm Greetings.

Welcome back to Term 2 of the 2026 academic year. We thank all parents and guardians for their continued support and partnership with the school.

### 1. Welcome to Term 2

We warmly welcome all students, staff, and parents back to school for Term 2. This term is academically very important, and we encourage all students to begin the term with seriousness, commitment, and discipline.

### 2. Daily Attendance and Proper Uniform

Parents are reminded to ensure that students attend school every day in full and proper school uniform with appropriate footwear. Students must also bring their water bottles daily to remain hydrated throughout the school day.

### 3. Curriculum Coverage and Academic Commitment

All curriculum coverage from Year 9 to Year 13 will be intensively covered during this term. Students are expected to attend all classes, complete all assignments, projects, and assessment tasks on time.

### 4. Retention Policy Now in Full Effect

Students who fail to meet curriculum coverage requirements, assessment and examination obligations, and attendance expectations may be required to repeat their current class level as per Ministry of Education guidelines.

### 5. Parent Notification Letters

Parents will receive official letters from the school should students fail to meet curriculum requirements, attendance expectations, or examination obligations. Please note if you are not on the class vibre group ensure your number is added at the earliest.

### 6. Eid-ul-Adha Holiday

Eid-ul-Adha will be observed on Thursday, 28th May 2026. School will remain closed on this day. Eid Mubarak to all families in advance.

### 7. Sports Training and Student Participation

Sports training will commence this week. Students wishing to participate must have proper parental consent, appropriate sports attire, and proper sports footwear. Satar (mandatory covering) must always be properly observed.

### 8. Mid-Year Examinations – Week 7

Mid-Year Examinations will be conducted during Week 7 of the term. These will be full-scale examinations, and all marks will be entered into FEMIS as sanctioned by the Ministry of Education.

## **9. Afternoon, Evening, and Saturday Classes**

Afternoon, evening, and Saturday classes will resume soon. Parents are strongly encouraged to send their children for these additional classes.

## **10. Late Arrival of Students**

Students arriving late to school must have genuine reasons. Parents are requested to ensure students leave home early enough to arrive at school on time.

## **11. Students Wasting Time at Navakai Shopping Area**

The school has received concerns regarding students wasting time around the Navakai Shopping area before school hours. This practice must stop immediately.

## **12. School Gate Opening and Closing Times**

The school gate closes at 8:30 AM and opens at 3:15 PM. Parents needing access during school hours are requested to call 2126209 or 9950750 beforehand.

Due to the importance of curriculum coverage during this term, early leave for students will not be permitted except in genuine emergencies.
